Don't Forget Your Education Tax Rebate

Winnipeg – Keystone Agricultural Producers (KAP) is reminding all farmers to apply for their farmland education tax rebate this fall. In 2007, farmers can receive a 65% rebate on the education taxes that they've paid on farmland, but must fill in an application form, which is available at municipal and provincial government offices.

Producers have three years to apply for the rebate, so farmers can apply for a rebate dating back to the 2004 tax year, as long as the form is filed by December 31, 2007.

The education tax rebate continues to grow, and will eventually reach 80% in 2010. KAP continues its work to shift education taxes off of property altogether, and to replace today's outdated and complicated system with an approach that is equitable and understandable for all Manitobans.
